Our Parks and Keeping Them Clean

As the warmer months come rolling in all neighbors need to keep an eye on our parks. This is something that hit home the day after our cleanup when the pavilion/picnic area of Adair Park II was left with trash all over the ground. Here are some specific requirements for use of any Atlanta park to remind our guests of:

All litter must be placed in receptacles. All pets must be on a leash, and owners must clean up after pets. No vehicles allowed off paved roads. No tents or canopies, or equipment that needs outside power without a permit. No glass containers. No amplified music, selling of food or alcoholic beverages except by special permit. No drugs or illegal substances.

Please be a good steward of Adair Park and if you see groups breaking these rules, mention it to the guests. If you do not feel comfortable doing so, call 911.
