

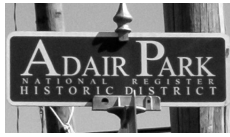

### Adair Park Crime Watch

Unfortunately, it has been a busy summer thus far for Adair Park. A few house breaks on Pearce and Oakhill, a car stolen on Elbert, a vacant house break-in on Catherine, vegetables taken from a backyard garden on Mayland—it is all over the neighborhood. While things are better than they have been in the past, that isn't easy to tell a victim of a crime. We need to eliminate this element from Adair Park!

The good news is we have been in constant contact with the Zone 3 Commander and other officers and have identified a few problem areas and houses.
