### Adair Park and Stray Dogs

As summer is upon us, the number of strays and mistreated animals in Adair Park seems to grow. Tethering dogs in this heat is not only bad for the dog, it is illegal. The ordinance basically states it is unlawful for the owner of a dog to tether a dog to restrain it. The only time this is okay is when it is done temporarily and the dog is being attended to. The tether must be attached to a collar or harness and may not be wrapped directly around the dog's neck. If you see a dog being mistreated, or see a collarless stray running the streets, please call Animal Control at 404-794-0358.

### Atlanta Police to Enforce Youth Curfews

City of Atlanta officials announced in June that police will be enforcing a longstanding youth curfew and fining parents of multiple offenders \$1,000 and making them subject to 60 days of jail or community service. A first offense draws a warning; a second offense leads to the tougher standards.

Police patrols will be increased for city parks, recreation centers, pools and potential problem areas. Teens 16 and under can't be out of their homes without adult supervision from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday, and from midnight to 6 a.m. on Fridays and Saturdays, according to the ordinance.

As part of the increased attention to the curfew, MARTA Police will have an increased presence on trains and buses, and at the Five Points MARTA station.
