Parallel Housing has agreed to purchase the land and do the project. The housing will be for persons 62 and older. This is affordable housing. Parallel has agreed to everything the other developer promised to do. A crosswalk will connect Adair Park 2 to Lounds. Low income tax credit is being used along with loans to finance this project. There will be a gated area at the entrance. A meeting space is available. 15 to 17 will not have income restrictions. There will be 91 units total with 69 – 1 bedroom and 22 – 2 bedroom. A van will be purchased for the residents. Community Garden will also be available. The expected completion date is June 2013 if all goes well in October with the the tax credits.
